Dear Parent/Carer,

Following on from the correspondence from Julie Calder, Head of Education, and Interim Chief Education Officer, on Thursday, I am writing to inform you of our plans at Castlehead High School.

The planned strike day for members of UNISON and GMB trade unions is planned for **Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> September**, **Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> September and Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> September** and while this does not involve teachers, it does involve staff who are vital to the safe and effective operation of our school, including support staff and catering, cleaning, and janitorial staff. Therefore, Castlehead High School in addition to all other schools in Renfrewshire will be closed on these three days.

While the school building will be closed, online learning will continue, and our teaching staff will be setting classwork on our SatchelOne platform to support our pupils over the course of the three days. Teaching staff will also be available to answer any questions and provide support during on the SatchelOne platform.
