<u>Cost</u>: £72 per pupil <u>Includes</u>: Transport, lunch and park entry.

Lunch is provided and includes an all you can eat buffet of pizza, pasta and salad with refillable drink.

Pupils will need to bring money to provide their own breakfast and dinner etc. The park has a variety of options for purchasing food and drinks Pupils may also bring a packed lunch with them. There are open air and covered picnic areas available for use.

<u>Cost</u>: £22 per pupil <u>Includes</u>: Transport and park entry.

Pupils may also bring a packed lunch with them. There are designated eating areas. It is not advised that pupils eat a heavy lunch before returning to the trampolines

The park has a variety of options for purchasing food and drinks. Pupils may also bring a packed lunch with them. Pupils should bring their own money if they would like to make purchases.


Availability

<u>Cost</u>: Free <u>Includes:</u> A free bike health check

There will be opportunities to purchase food at the RSPB Bird Sanctuary or at the Castle Semple Visitor Centre, Pupils must bring their own money or bring along a packed lunch in a rucksack etc. Pupils should keep a water / juice bottle with them.

Availability

There are 24 spaces available for this trip due to staff: pupil ratios. It is open to all year groups. If there are more that 20 pupils wishing to attend, then names will be drawn at random.

Pupils should bring in their bikes for a safety check. Bikes are available to borrow if required.

All pupils should have the ability to cycle unassisted 9.5 miles there and back. Cycle helmets must be worn at all times, while riding the bikes.
